So open wide the doorway - Thanksqiving comes again!


As we are coming through another difficult year and life is starting to see some normality again, services are being held, visitors are returning and weddings taking place. All activities are being planned with safety of upmost importance.

LOOKING BACK...

With the church closed for many months, resulting in the loss of many services, visitors and weddings, we closely looked at a recovery plan for when restrictions were lifted.

We were successful in obtaining a grant from the **Government's Culture Recovery Fund.** This helped us in...

- Creating a one-way "Heritage Tour" route around St Andrew's with new signage in and around the church
- Designing and printing a paper leaflet of this route with a few details of the more important and interesting areas
- Leading to a much more comprehensive historic guide around the church which can be downloaded to a smartphone or tablet via the Info Point
- Employing supervisors to welcome and monitor opening the church to visitors again.
