However, for us all, the war in Ukraine has cast a huge shadow and our thoughts and prayers have been focussed on the humanitarian disaster unfolding there. We appealed to our community to help in whatever way they could, and through a coffee morning, church service and generous donations from villagers and tourists, the amount raised to date is £1040. designated donation box in the centre of the church continues to welcome donations, and our Lent Lunch on Wednesday March 30^{th,} in the village hall between 10 and 12pm, will raise further essential funds to support our friends in Ukraine.

CHURCHYARD



The churchyard is bursting into life and has never looked more beautiful; there is a carpet of primroses in the rear garden, and the huge cherry is about to blossom. We have seen increasing numbers of visitors take a moment to pause, enjoy the peace, listen to the birdsong and appreciate the natural surroundings. We recently carried out a spring-clean of the church, and general tidy of the churchyard. Every task was accompanied by a robin or a blackbird. We have asked villagers to donate snowdrops in the green – we hope in a few years we will see a vision of white at the start of the year, also providing important nectar for early insects. The first plantings were added to

the military graves. We have had other donations to our new flowerbed joining the upper and lower churchyards, and together with wildflower seeding, hope to have a truly lovely and natural display this summer.
